Noontime Concerts is a 501(C)3 nonprofit education and arts organization dedicated to the presentation of free, high-quality, classical music performances to the public each week, performed by world-class musicians and talented emerging artists.






Noontime Concerts sustains the future of live classical music by providing performance opportunities for talented musical artists and exceptional programs, offered at no cost, to thousands of audience members each year. In 2019 we presented 58 concerts to approximately 8,000 live audience members.

In 2020 After 32 years of presenting weekly live-audience concerts, we were forced to close our doors due to the COVID 19 pandemic. Wasting no time we immediately committed to making major improvements to our audio-visual production capabilities. Free online weekly concerts began in mid-March 2020 with remastered recordings from our archives. Later in 2020, we began making and featuring new recordings and have continued to present free recorded concerts each week to thousands of local and international viewing and listening audiences.
